The Dublin, Ohio-based chicken chain is planning to open a fifth Louisville area location, this one at 5338 Bardstown Road, near the intersection with South Hurstbourne Parkway. Right now, it has locations on Preston Highway, Dixie Highway and Shelbyville Road in Louisville, as well as Greentree Boulevard in Clarksville.

Fern Creek Chicken Coop LLC, the company behind this new location, recently advertised for an alcoholic beverage license. The new location is listed as "coming soon" on the company's website, but no word on an opening date yet. I contacted Roosters Inc. earlier today but have not heard back yet. This story could be updated.

Roosters is focused on chicken wings and, according to <u>its menu online</u>, has 12 different sauces ranging from the lower-heat teriyaki sesame seed to the hottest level, called nu-killer. It also has burgers, salads, subs and pizzas.

Roosters, founded in Dayton in 1989, now has about 30 locations in Ohio, Kentucky, Indiana and West Virginia.
